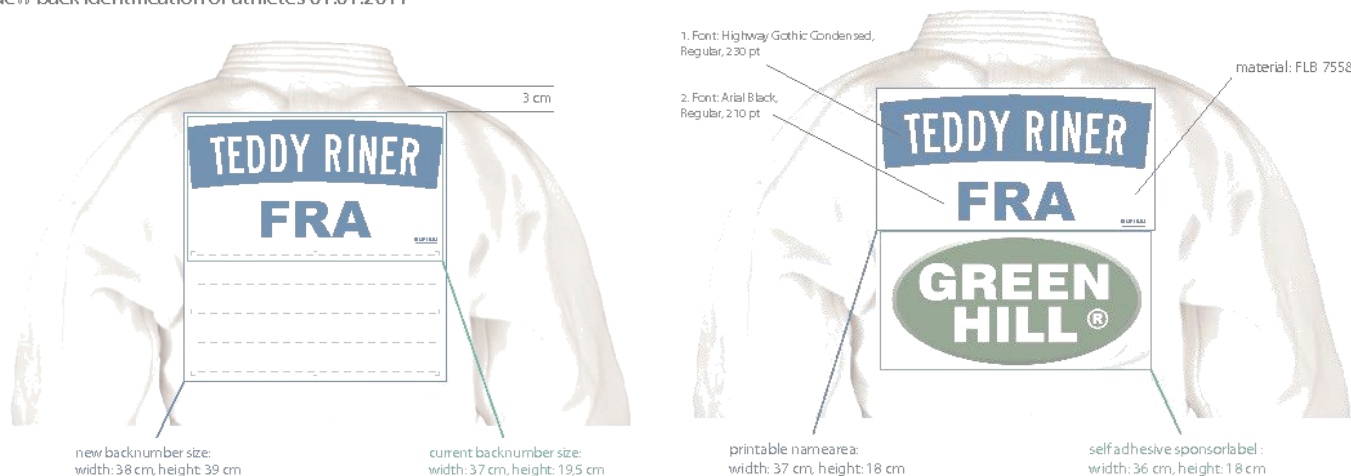
These details MUST be included in Junior European Cup Outlines – 2013

- NAME OF THE EVENT
 - **Junior European Cup** should appear in the name of event
 - Subtitle "**Top Ranking**" can be added under the name of events so classified in the EJU Junior Tour 2013
- EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBER
 - In case of emergency, change of flight schedule, etc, during the last week before the championships, please list at least 2 numbers which could be contacted at all times in these cases.
- CATEGORIES & DURATION
 - Male: **-55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100**
 - Female: **-44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78, +78**
 - Duration: **4 minutes** Golden Score: **No time limit**
- PARTICIPATION
 - Age Category: age 15 - 20 (**born 1998 – 1993**)
 - **All EJU / IJF affiliated countries**
 - Competitor can register and compete only for the country of which he holds the passport.
In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the Athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.
 - In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.
 - If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned.
 - According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. Jumas website : <https://jumas12.net/user/login>
- DRAW
 - Draw for all weight categories shall be held the night before the first day of the competition (suggested time 20:00hrs).
 - Draw shall be public with officials of all teams invited and competition sheets distributed right after the draw. EJU / IJF Dress Code: jacket suit with tie.
 - Seeding of the top 4 competitors in each weight category according to the EJU Junior RL. There will be no separation by nation within the seeded athletes in case there are 2 of the same nationality.
- COMPETITION SYSTEM
 - Double repechage competition system.
 - Competition systems with low number of participants:
 - 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide
 - 3,4,5 entries: round robin competition system
 - 6 and more entries: repechage competition system

Updated round robin rules valid from 2012 can be found in the EJU General Handbook on the EJU Website, Downloads section.

- WEIGH IN
 - Weigh In for each weight category shall be held on the same day as the competition.
 - EJU recommends at least 2.5 (two and a half) hours shall be provided between the end of the official, weigh-in and start of the competition. Minimum 2 hours must be observed.
 - Athletes must present accreditation card and **passport**. (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted)
- BACK NUMBERS
 - *The EJU will inform the organizer if the CHANGEABLE part is needed for that particular event. In this case, the organizer will deliver the CHANGEABLE part during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.*
 - Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating.
 - The below rules **MUST** be included in the technical rules by the organiser:
 - Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.
 - The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU backnumber ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or the IJF backnumber ordered from [http://www.ijfbacknumber.com/.](http://www.ijfbacknumber.com/) Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available.
 - The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.

- JUDO GI
 - **Blue & White Judogi is obligatory.** Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule.
 - **All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.** The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.
 - Only EJU sponsors can advertise on the shoulder stripes.
- REFEREEING
 - Referees Meeting should be in the morning on the first day of competition (suggested time 1 hour before the start of competition)
 - Each federation may enter 2 referees. The organizing federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the tournament. The requirement in refereeing is at least the highest national licence and some years of experience as a referee.

- Coaching
 - All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between Matte and Hajime (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between Matte and Hajime)
 - Dress Code:
 - Draw: jacket suit and tie
 - Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes, or jacket suit with tie
 - For the final block program: jacket suit with tie.

Information for National Federations (not for inclusion in the Outlines):

- EJU JUNIOR TOUR 2013
- Based on the statistical evaluation of events 2010 - 2012, the Junior European Cups are classified in 2 levels in the EJU Junior Tour 2013:
 - Junior E-Cup /Top Ranking:** GER, AUT, CZE, HUN, POL, RUS, ITA, UKR
 - Junior E-Cup:** POR, GRE, LTU, FRA, EST, ESP
 - The points scale for the EJU Junior Ranking List is set up accordingly
- EJU JUNIOR RANKING LIST:
 - Points are counted for 2 years – the previous year and running year.
 - The Ranking list after last E-Cup will be used for seeding at the draw of the EC Juniors.
 - Results of the Junior EC and the World Ch. will be counted for the final RL of the year.
 - See the EJU Junior Ranking List Rules 2013.
